

Scope of Work

Preparation of a mud slab to facilitate waterproofing work begins this month. Waterproofing installation below the raft slab foundations will take place throughout the site, including at the location of the tower crane base. By the end of the month, steel will be placed for the crane pad, the crane base will be set, and concrete will be poured to prepare for crane installation.


